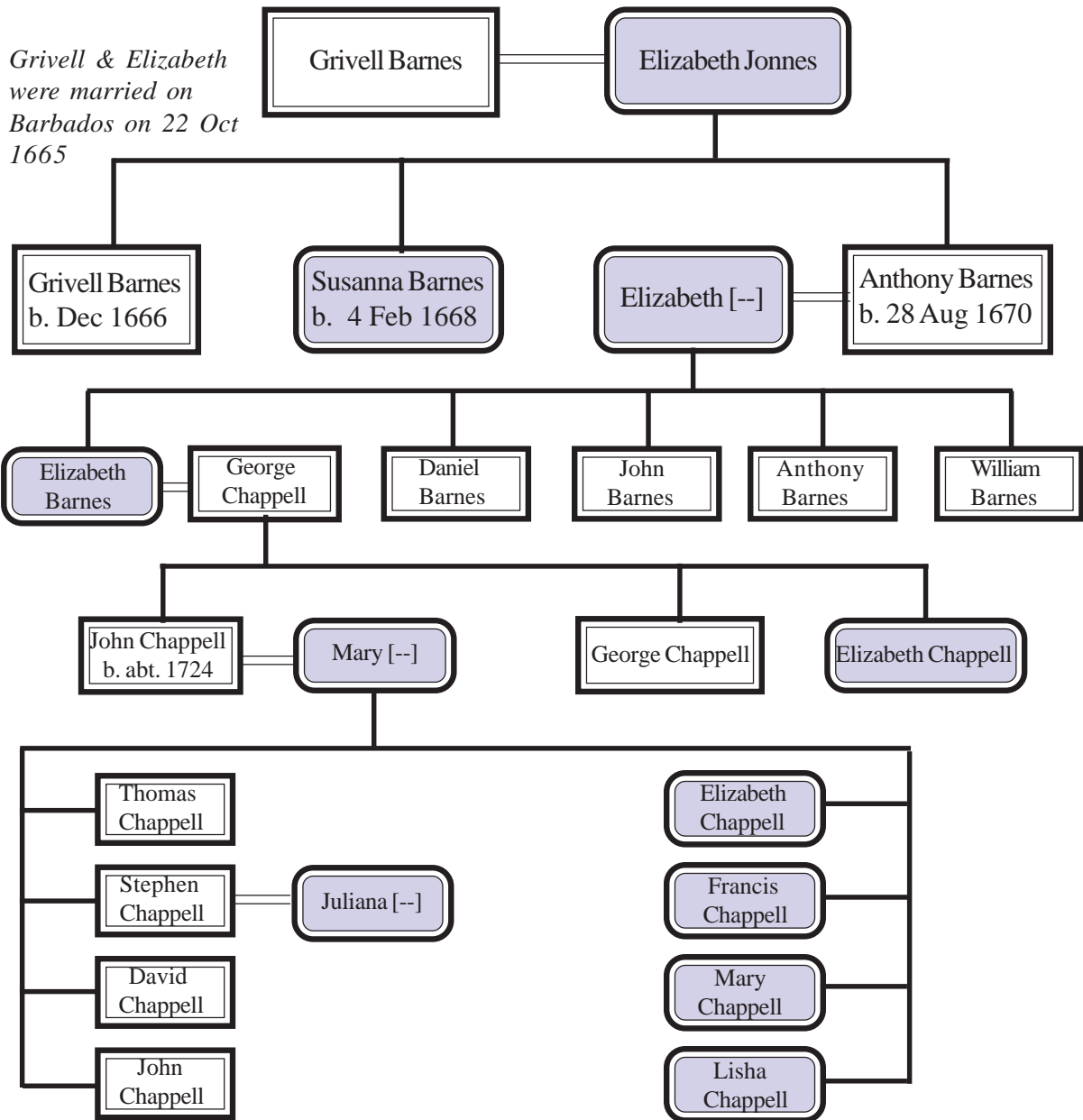


Descendants of Grivell Barnes and Elizabeth Jonnes



Although the evidence for this pedigree is highly suggestive, it is still lacking in absolute proof. The original Barnes information here was found in the records of St. Michael's Parish in the British Colony of Barbados. Grivell Barnes was almost certainly an indentured servant working on the sugar plantations. The usual term was for five years. I am supposing that this family then moved on to Princess Anne County, Virginia (present day Virginia Beach) and that the granddaughter, Elizabeth Barnes married George Chappell there about 1700.
